## **Ephesians 1:1-2**

### **An introduction to Paul**

Paul was originally named Saul and is first mentioned in Acts 7:58  
Saul was the one who held the coats at the death of Stephen - Acts 7:58  
Saul was in full agreement about the death of Stephen - Acts 8:1  
Saul chose to take the lead in trying to destroy the church - Acts 8:3  
Saul received permission to arrest any Christians in Damascus - Acts 9:1-2  
Saul was stopped by Christ on the road to Damascus - Acts 9:3-6  
Saul was chosen by God to take the Gospel to the Gentiles - Acts 9:10-22  
Saul was introduced to the apostles by Barnabas - Acts 9:23-29  
Saul then returned to Tarsus where he remained for ten years - Acts 9:30-31,  
Galatians 1:15-2:2  
Saul was brought by Barnabas to Antioch to help teach the Christians there -  
Acts 11:19-26  
Saul and Barnabas were sent out by the church at Antioch to take the Gospel  
to the Gentiles - Acts 13:1-3  
Saul had his name changed to Paul - Acts 13:9  
Paul spent nearly three years in Ephesus on his third missionary journey -  
Acts 19:1-20:1  
Paul wrote this book to the church at Ephesus while he was a prisoner in  
the city of Rome - Acts 28:11-16, 30-31

### **An introduction to the book of Ephesians**

**Paul wrote by the will of God**  
**Paul wrote to the Christians in Ephesus**  
**Paul wrote to all who are faithful in Christ Jesus**

### **Paul explained what he wanted for the Christians in Ephesus**

**Grace**  
the merciful kindness of God by which He turns us to Christ  
keeps, strengthens and increases us in the Christian faith  
and gives us His power to grow in godly character

**Peace**  
the inner tranquillity of a right relationship with God  
grace and peace come both from the Father and Christ

## **God is the One who chose and sealed us Ephesians 1:3-14**

this choice was made before creation - 1:3-4

this choice was to make us sons through Christ Jesus - 1:5-7

this choice also included knowing His will - 1:8-10

this choice also included an inheritance - 1:11-12

this choice was sealed by the Holy Spirit - 1:13-14

### **This choice was made before creation Ephesians 1:3-4**

#### **God is blessed and blesses us**

##### **God is the one who is blessed**

God is the One who deserves all praise and honor

##### **God is the One who also blesses us**

God also chooses to place His favor and praise on us

##### **God blesses us with all spiritual blessings**

this means that God will not withhold from us any spiritual blessing

##### **God blesses us in the heavenlies in Christ**

this means that our blessings are spiritual rather than physical

#### **God is the One who chose us**

##### **God chose us in to be in Christ**

being in Christ makes us a new creation

##### **God chose us before the creation of the world**

the decision to save us was made before Genesis 1:1

##### **God chose us to be holy**

this means we are set apart to God

##### **God chose us to be without blame**

this is the result of all our sins being placed on Christ

##### **God chose us to stand before Him in love**

because our sins were placed on Christ, we no longer stand in fear

**This choice was to make us sons through Christ Jesus  
Ephesians 1:5-7**

**God chose us according to His own will**

**God is the One who predestinated us to adoption**

to predestine means to determine beforehand  
to adopt means God determined to adopt us into His family

**God adopted us to Himself by Jesus Christ**

God made us His children

God made that possible through the death of Christ

**God adopted us according to the good pleasure of His will**

God adopted us because of His kind intent

God adopted us because He had determined that should be done

**God did this to the praise of the glory of His grace**

God made this choice so that He is the One who receives glory

God made this choice so that all we do can show His grace

**God made us accepted through Christ**

**God did this through His grace**

God chose us as a free gift of His grace

**God did this for us in the Beloved (Christ)**

God could do this for us because of the blood of Christ

**God said that it is in Christ that we have redemption**

**Christ provided redemption through His blood**

Christ is the One who paid the price to redeem us

Christ bought us back from the consequences of sin

Christ did this through the shedding of His blood

**Christ provided the forgiveness of sins**

God chose to let go of our sins because He is satisfied with the payment

**Christ did this according to the riches of His grace**

God's grace has no limits so He gives according to His grace

**This choice also included knowing His will  
Ephesians 1:8-10**

**God made His grace to overflow toward us**

**this overflowing is done in all wisdom**  
God chose to show His grace based on His perfect wisdom  
**this overflowing is done in all prudence**  
God chose to do this based on His perfect knowledge and holy love

**God made known to us the mystery of His will**

**God only reveals His will to those who are His friends**  
**John 15:15**  
**God has made His will known to us**  
the moment we become Christians we begin to understand  
the Word of God  
the will of God  
**God has made His will known to us because that pleases Him**  
that pleases Him because He wants to treat us as friends  
**God has made His will known to fulfill His purpose**  
God actually is fulfilling His purpose as He makes known His will to us

**God is going to complete all things in Christ**

**this will happen according to the time plan of God**  
God has the exact time for each part of His plan to be fulfilled  
**this will happen because He has placed all things in Christ**  
God will give us a summary of all things in Christ  
**this will happen in heaven**  
God will complete His plan in heaven  
**this will happen on earth**  
God will complete His plan on earth

## **This choice also included an inheritance Ephesians 1:11-12**

### **God has given us an inheritance**

#### **God chose us through Christ to receive this inheritance**

this inheritance makes us joint heirs with Christ - Romans 8:14-17

this inheritance is given by God to all Christians - Acts 20:32

this inheritance includes the Holy Spirit as a down payment - Ephesians 1:14

#### **God is the One who predestinated us**

to predestinate means to determine beforehand

to predestinate when God does it means to determine from eternity

God chose us to be sons from eternity - Ephesians 1:5

God chose to conform us to the image of Christ - Romans 8:29

God then called us, justified us and glorified us - Romans 8:30

#### **God predestinated us according to His purpose**

this purpose was the cause of our salvation - II Timothy 1:9

this purpose was His eternal purpose - Ephesians 3:11

this purpose is why God for Christians causes bad things to have good results -  
Romans 8:28

#### **God works out all things according to the counsel of His will**

God is the One who causes His counsel to stand - Isaiah 46:10

God is the One who works in us to complete His will - Philippians 2:13

God will fulfill His will by giving us eternal life - Titus 3:5-7

God has given an oath to back up this promise - Hebrews 6:17

### **God is the One who deserves all praise**

#### **God is the One who caused us to trust Christ**

the Father is the One who draws us to Christ - John 6:44

the Father is the One who gives us the faith to believe - Ephesians 2:8

#### **God did this to bring praise to His glory**

God is the one who deserves all praise - I Corinthians 10:31

God will even receive glory from Christ - I Corinthians 15:24-28

## **This choice was sealed by the Holy Spirit Ephesians 1:13-14**

### **God sealed us with the Holy Spirit**

#### **God caused us to hear the word of truth**

the word of truth has its source in Christ - Ephesians 4:20-21

the word of truth comes to us through Christ - John 1:17

the word of truth leads us to faith - Romans 10:17

#### **God caused us to receive the Gospel**

the word of truth is the source of the Gospel - Colossians 1:4-6

the word of truth effectively worked in us - I Thessalonians 2:13

#### **God caused us to believe in Christ**

God worked through the Gospel to cause us to believe - Romans 1:16

God worked through the Scriptures to cause us to believe - II Timothy 3:15

God worked through His grace to cause us to believe - Titus 2:11

God worked through other Christians to cause us to believe - Hebrews 2:3

#### **God sealed us with the Holy Spirit of promise**

this seal is our down payment on eternal life - II Corinthians 1:22

this seal has been placed in us until the day of redemption - Ephesians 4:30

### **God gave us the Holy Spirit as our guarantee of eternal life**

#### **the Holy Spirit is the guarantee of our inheritance**

the Spirit reminds us we are joint heirs with Christ - Romans 8:15-17

the Spirit reminds us of the coming redemption of our body - Romans 8:23

the Spirit reminds us He is our down payment - II Corinthians 5:5

the Spirit reminds us that we are children of God - Galatians 4:6

#### **the Holy Spirit provides this guarantee unto our full redemption**

our redemption was purchased by the blood of Christ - Acts 20:28

our redemption will be complete when we have a new body - Romans 8:23

#### **the Holy Spirit shows that we are now God's purchased possession**

the Holy Spirit reminds us we were bought with a price - I Corinthians 6:19-20

the Holy Spirit reminds us to glorify God both in body and in spirit - I Cor. 6:20

#### **The Holy Spirit causes all glory to go to God**

the glory belongs to God for His grace - Ephesians 1:6

the glory belongs to God for our salvation - Ephesians 1:12

## **Paul gave thanks for the Ephesians faith and love**

### **Ephesians 1:15-16**

### **Paul heard about the faith and love of the Ephesians**

#### **word had spread about their faith in Christ**

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other, II Thessalonians 1:3 (NKJV)

#### **word had spread about their love for each other**

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."  
John 13:34-35 (NKJV)

### **Paul thanked God for their faith and love**

#### **Paul prayed for them continually**

Paul prayed for Christians in many places continually  
Romans 1:8-9, I Corinthians 1:4, Philippians 1:3-4,  
Colossians 1:3, I Thessalonians 1:2, II Thessalonians 1:3

#### **Paul gave thanks for them continually**

Paul always gave thanks for God's work in their lives  
(see all of the above references)

#### **Paul prayed for them personally**

in Ephesians 3:14-21

we will see another prayer for the Ephesians  
we will see specific things he prayed for

## **Paul prayed for growth in wisdom and knowledge Ephesians 1:17-18**

### **God is the source of wisdom and knowledge**

#### **God is the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ**

Christ called Him the Father in His prayer in John 17:1-26

#### **God is the Father of glory**

the Father is the One who deserves all glory - I Chronicles 29:11

the Father of glory is the One to whom we pray - Matthew 6:9-13

the Father is the God of glory who appeared to Abraham - Acts 7:2

#### **God gives us the spirit of wisdom in the knowledge of Him**

the Spirit of wisdom is the Holy Spirit - Isaiah 11:2

the Spirit of wisdom is the Spirit of truth - John 14:17

the Spirit of wisdom is the One who teaches us - John 14:26

the Spirit of wisdom gives us the wisdom that is from above - James 3:17-18

#### **God gives us the spirit of revelation in the knowledge of Him**

the Spirit is the One who reveals things to us - I Corinthians 2:1

the Spirit reveals the love of Christ to us - Ephesians 3:18-19

### **God is the source of understanding**

#### **God causes the eyes of our understanding to be enlightened**

God is the One who opens our eyes - Psalm 119:18

God is the One who opens our understanding - Luke 24:45

God gives us light to give us understanding - II Corinthians 4:4-6

#### **God wants us to know the hope of His calling**

in the past we were without hope - Ephesians 2:12

in the present God wants us to know the hope of our calling - Ephesians 4:4

#### **God wants us to know the riches of His glory**

the riches of His glory made possible the forgiveness of sins - Ephesians 1:7

the riches of His glory provide strengthening of our inner man - Ephesians 3:16

the riches of His glory make it possible to know the love of Christ - Eph. 3:17-19

#### **God wants us to understand His inheritance to the saints**

that inheritance is all we will share with Christ - Romans 8:14-17

that inheritance includes eternal life - Acts 26:18

this inheritance includes the Holy Spirit as a down payment - Ephesians 1:14

## **Paul prayed for growth in understanding God's power Ephesians 1:19-21**

### **God wants us to know His power**

#### **the power of God is shown toward Christians**

this power is shown by creating us unto good works - Ephesians 2:10

this power is shown by giving us power to minister - Ephesians 3:7

this power means God will do through us more than we can imagine - Ephesians 3:20

#### **the power of God is working with mighty power**

the power of God is able to turn us from the power of Satan - Acts 26:18

the power of God is able to save - Romans 1:16

the power of God is able to make us new creations - II Corinthians 5:17

the power of God works in us to complete His will - Philippians 2:13

the power of God empowers our preaching - I Thessalonians 1:5

### **God wants us to understand why the resurrection shows His power**

#### **God showed His power in Christ**

the Father gave Christ power to rise again - John 10:18

#### **God showed His power by raising Christ from the dead**

this resurrection power is only understood as we grow - Philippians 3:10

#### **God showed His power by setting Christ at His right hand**

Christ is at His right hand interceding for us - Romans 8:34

#### **Christ is far above all principality, power, might and dominion**

the body of Christ makes both Jews and Gentiles fellow heirs - Ephesians 3:6

### **We were dead in trespasses and sins**

**we have been made alive**

Christ is the resurrection and the life - John 11:25-26

**we were dead in our sins**

our former condition was we were dead in our sins - Ephesians 2:5

### **We walked according to the pattern of Satan**

**we followed the pattern of the world**

we followed our old man which was corrupt - Ephesians 4:22

**we followed the pattern of Satan**

we followed the lusts of the devil - John 8:44

**we followed the spirit who deceives the world**

we followed the deceptions of evil spirits - I John 4:1-4

### **We walked according to the lusts of the flesh**

**our actions were controlled by the desires of our flesh**

we followed the flesh instead of the Spirit - Galatians 5:17-21

**our desire was to carry out the desires of our flesh**

we followed the desires of our flesh - Titus 3:3

**our desire was to carry out the desires of our mind**

**God gave us that faith as a gift**

we received Christ and eternal life as a gift - Romans 6:23  
we received that gift by believing in our hearts - Romans 10:9-10

**We have not been saved by our own works**

**God says our works will not save**

we cannot be saved by the works of the law - Romans 3:20  
we are saved apart from the works of the law - Romans 3:27-28

**God says no one is able to boast**

we can only glory in what the Lord has done - I Corinthians 1:29-31  
we were destroying ourselves when we followed our own way - Titus 3:3-5

**We have been created for good works**

**God is the workman who created us**

we were made by God - Psalm 100:3  
we are the work of God's own hands - Psalm 138:8  
we are God's building - I Corinthians 3:9

**God created us in Christ Jesus**

we were made a new creation in Christ - II Corinthians 5:17  
we are being brought to maturity in Christ - Hebrews 13:20-21

**God created us for good works**

we have been prepared for every good work - II Timothy 2:21  
we are to be thoroughly furnished unto all good works - II Timothy 3:14-17

**God appointed us to walk in good works**

we are to be an example of good works - Titus 2:6-8  
we are to practice good works and be fruitful - Titus 3:14

# **God is the One who brings Jews and Gentiles together**

## **Ephesians 2:11-18**

as Gentiles we had no hope - 2:11-13

as Gentiles we have been reconciled to God - 2:14-18

### **As Gentiles we had no hope**

**we did not have hope**

we did not have the hope of glory revealed to us - Colossians 1:26-27

**we were without God in the world**

we chose to substitute other things for God - I Corinthians 8:4-6

#### **In the past we were far away from God**

**God said that we were far away from Him**

we had our eyes blinded to God - Acts 26:18

**God has made us near Him by the blood of Christ**

we have now been reconciled to God by Christ - II Corinthians 5:18-21

we have been reconciled by the blood of Christ - Colossians 1:13-14

**As Gentiles we have been reconciled to God  
Ephesians 2:14-18**

**Christ is our peace**

**He is the One who made peace**  
we no longer face condemnation - Romans 5:1  
**He makes Jews and Gentiles one**  
we have been joined together in one body - Ephesians 4:16  
**He had broken down the wall of division**  
we are all one in Christ - Galatians 3:28

**Christ is the One who ended the enmity between Jews and Gentiles**

**He ended the enmity by His death**  
we can now enter the presence of God with boldness - Hebrews 10:19-22  
**He ended the division brought by the law**  
we are no longer under the curse of the law - Galatians 3:10-13  
**He brings us together as a new person**  
we are a new creation in Christ - Galatians 6:15  
**He makes peace between us**  
we have put off the old man and put on the new man - Colossians 3:9-10

**Christ is the One who has reconciled both Jews and Gentiles to God**

**He reconciled both Jew and Gentile to God**  
Christ made this peace through His blood - Colossians 1:20-22  
**He made us all a new man (a new unified body)**  
Christ made it possible for us to carry out the will of God - I Peter 4:1-2

**Christ brought the Gospel to both those far and those near**

**the Gentiles who were far off heard the Gospel**  
Christ accepts people of every nation - Acts 10:34-35  
**the Jews who were near heard the Gospel**  
Christ says the Gospel is for both Jew and Gentile - Romans 1:16

**Christ gave us both access to the Father by the Spirit**

we are living stones built on Christ, the chief cornerstone - I Peter 2:5-6

### Christ is building us all into a holy temple

**we are all to be fitly framed together**

God is the wise masterbuilder who uses us to build - I Corinthians 3:10-11

**we are to be growing into a holy temple**

God is building us into a holy temple - I Corinthians 3:17

God wants us a holy temple both in body and spirit - I Corinthians 6:19-20

### Christ is making us a fit dwelling place for God

**we are being built together**

we glorify God by becoming one - John 17:20-23

**we are being built into a dwelling place for God**

we are the temple of God and His Spirit dwells in us - I Corinthians 3:16

**we are having this happen through the Spirit**

God has given us His Spirit because He dwells in us - I John 4:12-13

**Paul was a prisoner for the sake of the Gentiles**

**Paul was given a special ministry to the Gentiles**

**this ministry of oversight was by the grace of God**  
the ministry of oversight was to fulfill the Word of God - Colossians 1:25  
**this ministry of oversight was given to Paul**  
this ministry was to be an apostle to the Gentiles - Romans 11:13

**Paul had a mystery revealed to him**

**this mystery was given by revelation**  
Paul learned the plan of God by direct revelation - Galatians 1:12-17  
**this mystery was written down by Paul**  
Paul was chosen by God to write down this mystery - Colossians 1:26-27

**Paul was to help people understand this mystery**

**this mystery can be learned by reading  
this mystery can be understood by us**

**Paul revealed a mystery that had not been made known**

**this mystery had not been known in the past**  
God had hidden various mysteries in the past - Colossians 1:25-26  
**this mystery is now revealed by the holy apostles and prophets**  
the apostles spoke about this mystery - Ephesians 3:8-9  
the prophets wrote about this mystery - Ephesians 3:3

## **The church is where Jews and Gentiles become one Ephesians 3:6-7**

### **Christ has made Jews and Gentiles fellow heirs**

**we as Gentiles have become fellow heirs with the Jews**

Christ broke down the wall between Jew and Gentile - Ephesians 2:13-22

Christ made us joint heirs with Him - Romans 8:14-17

**we have become part of the same body**

Christ made us one body by the cross - Ephesians 2:16

**we have become partakers of His promise**

Christ made us all a part of the family of God - Galatians 3:26-28

Christ made us heirs of His promise - Galatians 3:29

**we have had this happen through Christ**

Christ is the One who made us His body - I Corinthians 12:27

**we have received this message by the gospel**

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law - Galatians 3:13-14

### **Christ gave Paul the privilege of sharing this message**

**Paul was made a minister by Christ**

Christ is the One who made Paul a minister - I Timothy 1:12-17

Christ showed mercy to Paul - I Timothy 1:13

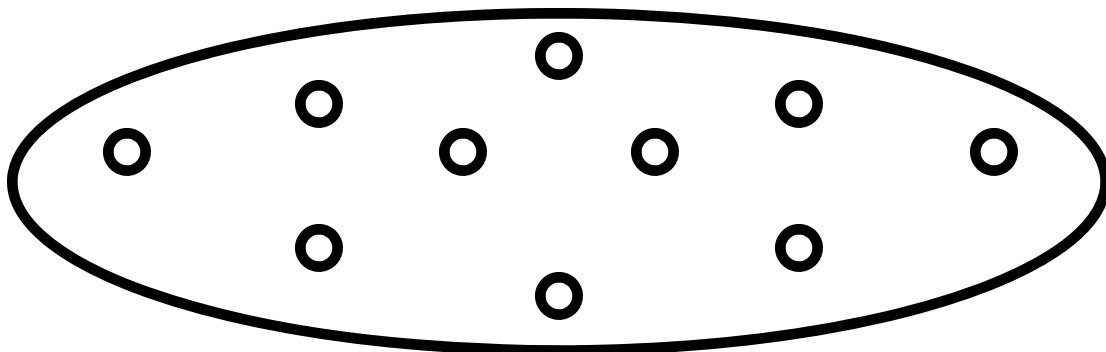
**Paul had been given this gift by grace**

**this mystery is the basis of fellowship for all men**

Paul had been given a commission to all the Gentiles - II Timothy 4:17

**this mystery was hidden by God**

Paul said this mystery was not known in other ages - Ephesians 3:5

### **Paul was revealing the greatness of the wisdom of God**

**this wisdom was being revealed through Paul**

Paul had been chosen to reveal the hidden wisdom of God - I Corinthians 2:7

**this wisdom was not revealed to the angels**

Peter says that there are many things the angels desire to know - I Peter 1:12

### **Paul was revealing the eternal purpose of God**

**this purpose was the eternal purpose of God**

God had this purpose from eternity past - Ephesians 1:3-12

**this purpose was carried out in Christ Jesus**

God called us through Christ according to His purpose - II Timothy 1:9

### **Paul was revealing the access that we have through Christ**

**we have boldness because of Christ**

we can come through Christ with boldness - Hebrew 4:14-16; 10:19-22

**we have confident access through faith in Christ**

we have access to God through Christ - Ephesians 2:18

# **God is the One who is able to do more through us than we can ever imagine Ephesians 3:13-21**

Paul gives us a model for prayer - 3:13-15

Paul prayed that Christians would be strengthened with might by the  
Spirit in the inner man - 3:16

Paul prayed that Christians would become rooted in the love of Christ- 3:17-19a

Paul prayed that Christians would be filled with the fullness of God - 3:19b

Paul prayed that Christians would see God work beyond our imagination  
through our lives - 3:20-21

## **Paul gives us a model for prayer Ephesians 3:13-15**

### **This prayer did not focus on Paul**

**Paul did not want the Christians to get discouraged**  
we will be rewarded if we do not faint - Galatians 3:8-10  
we are not to get tired of doing good - II Thessalonians 3:13  
**Paul was willing to suffer for the sake of other Christians**  
he was glad his suffering caused boldness in others - Philippians 1:12-14

### **This prayer was to the Father**

**Paul bowed his knees to the Father**  
Paul continually bowed his knees for the Ephesians - Ephesians 1:16-19  
Daniel and many others showed humbleness before God in prayer - Daniel 6:10  
**Paul recognized the relationship between the Father and Christ**  
this relationship brings glory to both - John 17:1-6

### **This prayer was to the Father of all saints**

**God is the Father of all saints now in heaven**  
this includes all Old Testament saints - Ephesians 4:8-10  
this includes all New Testament saints who have died - I Thessalonians 4:13-18  
**God is the Father of all saints still on the earth**  
we are all the children of God and will be like Him - I John 3:1-3

**Paul prayed that the Christians would be strengthened with  
might by the Spirit in the inner man  
Ephesians 3:16**

**this strength comes from the Father**  
this growth in strength was modeled by Christ - Luke 2:40  
this strength comes as we humble ourselves before God - I Peter 5:6  
**this strength is according to the riches of His glory**  
our forgiveness is based on His riches - Ephesians 1:7  
our inheritance is based on His riches - Ephesians 1:18  
our kindness that we will receive is based on His riches - Ephesians 2:7  
**this strength comes through the power of the Spirit**  
the Spirit is our only source of power - Acts 24:49; Acts 1:8  
**this strength becomes present in our inner man**  
this strength gives us His power - Colossians 1:11  
this strength renews our inner man day by day - II Corinthians 4:16

**Paul prayed that the Christians would become rooted in the  
love of Christ  
Ephesians 3:17-19a**

**we are to be rooted and grounded in the love of Christ**

**Christ dwells in our hearts by faith**  
Christ lives in us so we can live by faith - Galatians 2:20  
Christ is greater than he that is in the world - I John 4:4  
**Christ roots us and grounds us in His love**  
Christ roots us in Himself and in His love - Colossians 2:6-7

**we are to comprehend the greatness of the love of Christ**

**we can comprehend this love only as we are rooted in it**  
we become rooted by spending time with Christ - John 13:34-35  
**we are to understand the four dimensions of Christ's love**  
His love fills both space and time - Ephesians 1:4  
**we are to know Christ's love which surpasses human knowledge**  
the thoughts and ways of God are beyond human understanding - Isaiah 55:8-9  
the love of Christ becomes what motivates us - II Corinthians 5:14-15

**Paul prayed that Christians would be filled with the  
fullness of God

**understanding the fullness of God**  
to be filled with God is to be emptied of self  
we are to be filled with God - Ephesians 3:19  
we are to be filled with Christ - Ephesians 4:13  
we are to be filled with the Spirit - Ephesians 5:18

**Paul prayed that Christians would see God work beyond our  
imagination through our lives  
Ephesians 3:20-21**

**God is able to do more than we could ever ask or imagine**

**now  
now to Him  
now to Him who is able  
now to Him who is able to do  
now to Him who is able to do exceedingly  
now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly  
now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all**

**that we ask  
that we ask or think**

**according to the power that works in us**

**God is the One who is to receive all glory**

**this glory is to be given to God  
this glory is to be given by the church  
this glory is to be given through Christ Jesus  
this glory is to be given throughout all ages  
this glory is to be given through eternity**

##### **Paul wanted all Christians to walk worthy of our calling**

a worthy walk is a walk in love - Ephesians 5:2

#### We are to walk with a humble attitude

##### **this attitude includes a humble opinion of self**

we are to give preference to one another - Romans 12:10

we are to view others as better than ourselves - Philippians 2:3

##### **this attitude is an attitude of gentleness**

gentleness is a part of the fruit of the Spirit - Galatians 5:22-23

gentleness is the attitude we are to have as we restore others - Galatians 6:1

gentleness is an attitude we are commanded to put on - Colossians 3:12

gentleness is the attitude we are to have toward those who oppose - II Timothy 2:25

##### **this attitude is an attitude of patience**

patience is a part of the fruit of the Spirit - Galatians 5:22-23

patience is an attitude that we are to put on - Colossians 3:12

patience is an attitude that we are to have as we preach the Word - II Timothy 4:2

##### **this attitude is an attitude of endurance**

we are to bear with one another and forgive one another - Colossians 3:13

we are to endure when we experience persecutions - II Thessalonians 1:4

##### **this attitude is an attitude of love**

true love bears the infirmities of others - Romans 15:1

true love bears all things - I Corinthians 13:7

**We are to keep the unity produced by the Spirit**

**the Spirit has already produced unity**  
this unity began with the Godhead - John 17:21-23

this unity will produce peace and edification of one another - Romans 14:17-19

Christ reconciled us all to God in one body - Ephesians 2:16  
**there is one Spirit**  
the Spirit gave us different gifts and ministries - I Corinthians 12:4-11  
**there is one hope in our calling**  
Christ will make us like Himself when He appears - I John 3:1-3

**We are to keep the unity of Christ**

**there is one Lord**  
Christ is Lord of both the living and the dead - Romans 14:8-9  
**there is one faith**  
Christ wants us all to come to the unity of the faith - Ephesians 4:13  
**there is one baptism**  
we were all baptized into Christ - Romans 6:3-4

**We are to keep the unity of the Father**

**there is one God and Father of all**  
there is one God, the Father - I Corinthians 8:5-6  
**He is above all**  
the Father is above all principality and power - Ephesians 1:15-21  
**He is through all**  
the Father is the One through whom all things happen - Romans 11:33-36

#### **He has given grace to each of us**

**every Christian has been given grace**  
we have all been given grace and spiritual gifts - Romans 12:3-8  
**every Christian has received the gift of Christ**  
we have all been given a gift to minister to one another - I Peter 4:10-11

#### **He ascended on high and gave gifts to men**

**Christ ascended up on high**  
this happened the day He arose - John 20:17  
**Christ led captivity captive**  
this happened to fulfill an Old Testament promise - Psalm 68:18  
**Christ gave gifts to men**  
this happened so we can serve one another - I Peter 4:10-11

#### **He descended into the lower parts of the earth**

**Christ was the One who ascended**  
He had promised He would ascend where He was before - John 6:62  
**Christ first descended into the lower parts of the earth**  
He descended into paradise - Luke 23:39-43; I Peter 3:18-19

#### **He ascended far above the heavens**

**Christ ascended far above the heavens**  
He is at the right hand of the Father - Hebrews 7:26-8:1  
**Christ is the One who fills all things**  
He fills all places - I Kings 8:27; Acts 7:47-50

### **Christ gives spiritual leaders to the church**

#### **Apostles and Prophets were given as a foundation for the church**

the apostles and prophets are the foundation of the church - Ephesians 2:19-22

the apostles gave eyewitness testimony of the resurrection - Acts 1:21-22

the prophets gave us the written Word of God - II Peter 1:19-21

#### **Evangelists are given to build the church**

every Christian is commissioned to make disciples - Matthew 28:18-20

every Christian needs to be equipped to preach the Gospel - Romans 10:14-15

#### **Pastors are given to build the church**

pastor is translated shepherd in all other passages - John 10:11-16

shepherds equip the saints for several ministries - Ezekiel 34:4-6, 11-16

#### **Teachers are given to build the church**

Paul was a teacher who equipped the saints - I Timothy 2:7

### **Christ gives spiritual leaders to equip the saints for ministry**

#### **spiritual leaders are to equip the saints**

spiritual leaders are to equip the body and mature it - I Corinthians 1:10

#### **spiritual leaders equip the saints for ministry**

spiritual leaders equip us for every good work to do His will - Hebrews 13:20-21

#### **spiritual leaders equip the saints to build up the body**

the body is built up externally as we are equipped to evangelize - Mark 16:15

the body is built up internally as we are equipped to minister to one another  
in love - John 13:34-35

the body is built up in maturity as we are equipped to obey the Word of God  
and teach it - Matthew 7:24-27; II Timothy 2:2

#### **The saints are to be built up to function properly**

**Ephesians 4:13-16**

**The evangelists, pastors and teachers equip the saints to build**

**Ephesians 4:11-12**

**The apostles and the prophets are the foundation - Ephesians 2:19-22**

**Christ is the chief cornerstone - Ephesians 2:19-22**

## **Christ wants every Christian to become mature Ephesians 4:13-14**

### **The will of God is for Christians to become mature**

#### **this includes coming to the unity of the faith**

we are all to be of one accord - Acts 1:14; Acts 4:32

#### **this includes growth in the knowledge of the Son of God**

we are to grow in our knowledge of Christ - Philippians 3:8-10

#### **this includes growing to spiritual maturity**

we are to grow to spiritual maturity - II Timothy 3:14-17

#### **this includes growing in Christlikeness**

we are to grow and become more and more like Christ - I John 3:1-3

### **The will of God for Christians is that we would not remain toddlers**

#### **toddlers (children who cannot speak clearly) are not the goal of God**

toddlers are still walking like non-Christians - I Corinthians 3:1-3

#### **toddlers are tossed to and fro**

toddlers are weak in faith and doubleminded - James 1:4-8

#### **toddlers are carried about by every wind of doctrine**

toddlers are easily deceived by false teaching - II Timothy 4:3-4

#### **toddlers are deceived by the slight of man**

toddlers follow men instead of Christ - Acts 20:30

#### **toddlers are deceived by the cunning craftiness of false teachers**

toddlers are often deceived by false teachers - Acts 20:29

### **The tragedy of toddlers**

- ♦ toddlers act like people who are not Christians - I Corinthians 3:1
- ♦ toddlers are not able to understand difficult teachings from the Bible - I Cor. 3:2

**we are to recognize Christ as the head**  
Christ is the head of the church - Ephesians 1:22  
Christ is the head of the body - Colossians 1:18

**The will of God is for Christians to learn to function effectively**

**Christ is the One who joins the whole body together**  
we all are to abide in Christ - John 15:5  
**Christ is the One who keeps us united as one body**  
Christ is the Head who binds us together - Colossians 2:19  
**Christ wants every person to do his or her part**  
every part has an important ministry - I Corinthians 12:12-28  
**Christ wants us to work together in His power**  
we are to work together as one body - I Corinthians 12:14-20  
we can do nothing in our own power - John 15:5; Acts 1:8  
we can do all things through Christ's power - Philippians 4:13  
**Christ says every Christian working effectively is His standard**  
toddlers do not work because they are self centered - I Corinthians 3:1-3

toddlers do not work because they are dull of hearing and are not exercising  
their senses to discern good and evil - Hebrews 5:11-14

healthy Christians speak the Word with boldness - Acts 4:31; Acts 8:4  
healthy Christians lead others to Christ - John 1:40-41; Acts 11:19-21  
**Christ says this will also cause the body to build itself up in love**  
healthy Christians love one another - John 13:34-35  
healthy Christians bear one another's burdens - Galatians 6:2

### **Ephesians 4:17-19**

#### **The Gentiles walk in the evilness of their mind**

**the Lord is speaking through Paul**

Paul was writing the commandments of the Lord - I Corinthians 14:37

**the Lord does not want us to walk like our past life**

we were in darkness but now are to walk in the light - Ephesians 5:8

**the Lord does not want us to walk in the evilness of our mind**

as a man thinks in his heart, so is he - Proverbs 23:7

#### **The Gentiles have their understanding darkened**

**they have their understanding darkened**

we formerly followed the desires of the mind - Ephesians 2:3

**they are alienated from the life of God**

we were formerly alienated from God - Colossians 1:21

**they are separated by the ignorance that is in them**

this ignorance left us without knowledge of God - Acts 17:30

**their hearts are filled with blindness**

our foolish heart was darkened - Romans 1:21-23

#### **The Gentiles have given themselves over to sin**

**they are beyond feeling guilt, shame or grief**

they have their conscience seared - I Timothy 4:2

**they have given themselves over to outrageous sin**

this has led to every form of sin - Romans 1:24-28

**they are doing all wild living and desire more**

they take pleasure in their evil - Romans 1:29-32

## **The Christian is to put off our past lifestyle Ephesians 4:20-22**

### **Christ did not teach us our former lifestyle**

we have become dead to our former lifestyle - Romans 6:1-2  
we are now motivated by the love of Christ for us - II Corinthians 5:14-15  
we are now to live godly in this present world - Titus 2:11-14

### **Christ has taught us a new lifestyle**

#### **we have heard Christ**

we as the sheep of Christ hear His voice - John 10:4, 14  
we have heard the truth through Christ - Ephesians 1:13

#### **we have been taught by Christ**

the law came by Moses but truth came by Christ - John 1:17  
we have been taught by Christ through the Spirit - John 14:26

#### **we have learned the truth through Christ**

Christ is the way and the truth - John 14:6  
Christ has given us the Spirit of truth - John 14:16-17

### **Christ has taught us to put off the old man**

#### **we are to put off our former lifestyle**

we are to put off the works of darkness - Romans 13:12  
we are to put off the the attitudes that cause evil speaking - Colossians 3:8  
we are to lay aside every hindrance and sin - Hebrews 12:1

#### **we are to put off our old man**

we have put off the old man and his deeds - Colossians 3:9  
our old man was crucified with Christ - Romans 6:1-6

#### **we are to realize our old man is corrupt**

our old man caused us to be slaves to sin - Romans 6:6

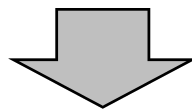

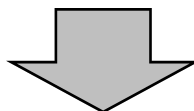

**a sinful heart may produce a fornicator**

a fornicator is a person who has given himself to sex sin - I Corinthians 5:9-11

#### **husbands are to sanctify and cleanse their wives**

cleansing happens through confession of sin - I John 1:9

husbands are to model the Word for their wives - James 1:22

#### **husbands are to present their wives as glorious wives**

spiritual fathers are to admonish spiritual children - I Thessalonians 5:12

**our fight is against powers**

Satan is the prince of the power of the air - Ephesians 2:2

God delivered us from the power of darkness - Colossians 1:13

**our fight is against spiritual wickedness in high places**

Satan is the wicked one - I John 2:13-14

**Christ has already clothed us with certain things in order to stand**

**we have had our loins girded with truth**

we are to be committed to knowing the truth - John 8:31-32

we are to be committed to obeying the truth - James 1:22

**we have been given the breastplate of righteousness**

we have been given the righteousness of Christ - Philippians 3:9

we are to grow in our obedience to that righteousness -Philippians 3:10-14

**we have had our feet shod with the gospel of peace**

we have the peace of God controlling our hearts and minds - Philippians 4:4-7

we have the God of peace with us in spiritual battle - Philippians 4:8-9

**Christ tells us to take certain things in order to stand**

**we are to take the shield of faith**

the shield of faith provides protection from temptation - I Corinthians 10:12-13

this faith gives us an eternal viewpoint - II Corinthians 4:16-18

this faith quenches all the fiery darts of Satan - I Peter 5:8-9

this faith causes us to know the wicked one cannot touch us - I John 5:18-19

**we are to take the helmet of salvation**

the helmet of salvation is the hope of salvation - I Thessalonians 5:8

that hope is based on the resurrection of Christ - I Corinthians 15:12-21

that hope is based on the return of Christ - I Thessalonians 4:13-18

### **The sword of the Spirit is one of our weapons**

#### **we are to take the sword of the Spirit**

the sword of the Spirit is greater than a human sword - Hebrews 4:12

the sword of the Spirit defeats Satan - Matthew 4:4, 7, 10-11

#### **we are to realize that the sword of the Spirit is the Word of God**

the Word of God is living and powerful - Hebrews 4:12

the Word of God is greater than our words - Isaiah 55:8-9

the Word of God will take away our fear of man - Hebrews 13:5-6

### **Prayer is our other weapon**

#### **we are to pray always**

we are to pray at all times - I Thessalonians 5:17

we are to pray for all people - I Timothy 2:1

we are to pray in all places - I Timothy 2:8

#### **we are to pray with prayer and supplication**

prayer speaks of general prayer addressed to God - Colossians 4:2, 12

supplication (petition) refers to specific requests to God - Philippians 4:6

#### **we are to pray in the Spirit**

we pray to the Father through the Spirit - Romans 8:15

we pray in the Spirit for the will of God - Romans 8:26-27

#### **we are to pray with all perseverance**

we are to continue in prayer to avoid temptation - Matthew 26:41

we are to continue in prayer until Christ comes - Mark 13:33-37

we are to continue in prayer and watch - Colossians 4:2

#### **we are to pray with all supplication (petition)**

we are to pray for forgiveness - Matthew 6:12, I John 1:9

we are to pray for victory over temptation - Matthew 6:13

we are to pray for the salvation of others - Romans 10:1

we are to pray for the ministry of one another - II Corinthians 1:11

we are to pray for Christians in other areas - II Corinthians 9:14

we are to pray for victory for one another - James 5:16

#### **we are to pray for all saints**

we are to pray for the spiritual growth of all Christians - Ephesians 3:14-21

we are to pray for fruitfulness for all Christians - Colossians 1:9-13

Paul wanted people to pray that the Word would spread quickly - II Thess. 3:1

#### **he asked them to pray he would open his mouth boldly**

when we spend time with Christ we can speak boldly - Acts 4:13  
when we are filled with the Spirit we can speak boldly - Acts 4:31  
when we are filled with hope we can speak boldly - II Corinthians 3:4-12

#### **he asked them to pray that he would be able to share the Gospel**

Paul was chosen to reveal the mystery of the gospel - Ephesians 3:3-7  
Paul had a goal to share the Gospel where it had not been heard - Romans 15:20-21  
Paul had a goal to bring people to maturity - Colossians 1:26-29

### **Paul had a desire to speak to please God**

#### **this is because Christians are ambassadors for God**

we are ambassadors for Christ to call people to be reconciled to God  
II Corinthians 5:20

#### **this is because we are to speak boldly**

we are to speak boldly and without fear - Philippians 1:12-14  
we are to speak with the love that casts out fear - I John 4:18

#### **this is because speaking boldly is the way we ought to speak**

we are to obey God rather than men - Acts 5:29  
we are to speak the Word with confidence - Acts 28:31  
we are to speak the Word of God without shame - Philippians 1:20  
we are to make the Gospel clear to others - Colossians 4:3-4  
we are to speak the Word even when facing opposition - I Thessalonians 2:2  
we are to be willing to lay down our lives as we speak - I John 3:16  
we are to be bold as we contend for the faith - Jude 3

## **God wants us to be concerned for one another Ephesians 6:21-24**

Paul sent Tychicus to tell what was happening to him - 6:21-22

Paul wanted the brethren to experience peace and love - 6:23-24

### **Paul sent Tychicus to tell what was happening to him Ephesians 6:21-22**

#### **Tychicus was a faithful servant of God**

**he would tell how Paul was doing**

Paul realized how God was working - Philippians 1:12

**he was a beloved brother**

Paul had a real love for Tychicus - Colossians 4:7

**he was a faithful servant of God**

Paul had added Tychicus to his ministry team - Acts 20:4

#### **Tychicus was sent to encourage the Ephesians**

**he was sent with a purpose**

Paul sent Tychicus to encourage the brethren - Colossians 4:7-8

**he would tell what was happening to Paul**

Paul wanted to keep the Christians informed - Colossians 4:9

**he would encourage the Ephesians**

Paul knew that Tychicus had a ministry of encouragement - II Timothy 4:12

### **Paul wanted the brethren to experience peace and love Ephesians 6:23-24**

#### **Peace is something God wants us all to experience**

**peace can be our experience**

peace has its source in the Father and Christ - Romans 1:7

**love with faith comes from the Father and Christ**

love has its source in the Father and Christ - John 17:23

**Grace is present with all who love Christ**
