As many of you know, in the fall of 2007, we were blessed by the generosity of some local churches who came in and made some much needed repairs and upgrades to our home — which is also used as our local office. We have greatly appreciated the benefits of their labor which has helped us to be more effective servants as we serve with AIBI.

Over the past several years, when we have been able to take the opportunity to go to Southern CA, our time has been spent in making contact with supporters, having face-to-face contact with fellow AIBI staff and helping with much needed repairs/upgrades in the main AIBI office space which is located at President Duane Anderson's home. Because of our previous experience in making repairs to the Anderson's home/AIBI main office, we were approached by individuals wishing to help out with some of the needed repairs/updates at the Anderson's home. With the same spirit of generosity and serving, this group of supporters is planning a work project this next year to meet the Anderson's needs and thus increase the effectiveness of their ministry.

Part of the work project will be relocating the office from a small bedroom to a larger "den" space that has not been able to be temperature controlled because of various needed repairs/upgrades. This larger room will help facilitate meeting space and more effective use of office and storage areas. It is exciting to see how the Lord uses His people to help meet tangible needs. In light of the office relocation, there is much preparation, sorting and packing which needs to take place before the project can be done as the area includes a large library, numerous AIBI file cabinets, equipment, etc. We are planning on traveling down to CA over the kid's Christmas break to help out in the preparation. This will be the first time we have been in California for Christmas since before we were married eighteen years ago. Since both sets of our parents are down in the area, it will be a rare opportunity to hopefully be able to spend a little of the remaining time with them during the busy holiday season.
